

Six Travel Privacy Policy

1. INTRODUCTION.

SixApp, Inc., a Delaware corporation ("**Six**", "**we**," "**us**" or "**our**"), considers your privacy a top priority and is committed to protecting it through our compliance with this policy (the "**Privacy Policy**"). This Privacy Policy describes the types of information we may collect from you or that you may provide when you access, visit, browse, purchase, redeem, take advantage of, benefit from, enjoy, participate in, sign up for, interact with and/or use in any other way any feature, component or portion of (each of the foregoing, both individually and collectively, "**Use**") the website located at six.travel (the "**Site**"), the mobile application called "**Six Travel**" (the "**Application**"), the webview (also known as a hybrid application) that may be activated when you 'click' or otherwise select the "Six Travel" affiliate marketing button or link that may be present on various third party mobile applications, mobile webpages, social networks, websites, blogs and other online resources, and which provides access to various Services (defined below) or Content (defined below) (the "**Webview**", together with the Site and the Application, the "**Services**"), each of which is owned by and operated on behalf of us, along with our practices and policies for collecting, using, maintaining, protecting, and disclosing that information. Please note that this Privacy Policy, as it may be amended, restated, modified and updated, is incorporated in its entirety into, and forms part of, the Terms of Service that govern any Use of the Site, the Application and Webview. Any capitalized term not defined in this Privacy Policy shall have the meaning given to such term in the Terms of Service. For the avoidance of doubt, this Privacy Policy applies to any Use of the Site, the Application or the Webview, whether or not you have an account with us and whether you are acting on behalf of yourself or any other individual or entity.

This Privacy Policy applies to information we collect or make available:

- 1.1.1.on or through the Services;
- 1.1.2.in email, text, and other electronic messages between you and the Services or Six;
- 1.1.3.in and from any User Information or other information or materials you may upload to the Services or otherwise provide to Six;
- 1.1.4.through any online publication Six may offer in connection with the Services and/or any Travel Services but only if you choose to sign up for that online publication;
- 1.1.5.in connection with any Use of the Services by you in connection with a Travel Service (including but not limited to booking and paying for a Travel Service);
- 1.1.6.from a Supplier about your Use of a Travel Service;

1.1.7. when you interact with our applications, content, and advertising on third-party websites and services, if those applications, content or advertising include links to this Privacy Policy; and

1.1.8. in the event you are an Influencer (defined below), if and when you register or login to the Services through the Instagram Login.

Except to the extent it expressly states otherwise, this Privacy Policy does not apply to information collected by:

1.1.9. Six offline or through any other means, including on, at or through any website other than the Services, any mobile application other than the Application or through any online button or link that is not the Webview, whether or not that information source is operated by or on behalf of Six and/or by or any third party; or

1.1.10. any third party, including through any application, advertisement or content that may link to or be accessible from, on or through the Services.

PLEASE READ THIS PRIVACY POLICY CAREFULLY TO UNDERSTAND OUR POLICIES AND PRACTICES REGARDING YOUR INFORMATION AND HOW WE WILL TREAT IT. IF YOU DO NOT AGREE WITH THESE POLICIES AND PRACTICES, YOUR SOLE CHOICE IS NOT TO USE ANY OF THE SERVICES IN ANY WAY. BY USING ANY OF THE SERVICES IN ANY WAY, YOU AGREE TO THIS PRIVACY POLICY. THIS PRIVACY POLICY MAY CHANGE FROM TIME TO TIME. YOUR CONTINUED USE OF ANY OF THE SERVICES AFTER WE MAKE ANY CHANGES TO THIS PRIVACY POLICY IS DEEMED TO BE YOUR ACCEPTANCE OF THOSE CHANGES, SO PLEASE CHECK THE PRIVACY POLICY PERIODICALLY FOR UPDATES.

2. CONCERNING CHILDREN.

Six does not knowingly collect personal information from minors. If we become aware that a minor is attempting to submit personal information, we will remove this information from our records. If you are the parent/legal guardian of a minor who has given us personal information, please contact us at hello@six.travel so we can delete it.

3. INFORMATION PROVIDED BY OR ABOUT YOU THAT WE COLLECT.

We collect several types of information from and about Users of the Services, including:

- 3.1. if and when you create an Account for the Services, sign up for any online publication we may publish, or in connection with Using (including but not limited to booking or paying for) a Travel Service, information by which you may be personally identified ("**Personal Information**") possibly including, but not necessarily limited to: your first and last name, your email address, your phone number, your date of birth, and your address as well as possible some additional biographical information about you such as but not necessarily limited to: your gender, education, profession;
- 3.2. your search queries on any of the Services and any information about how you use the Services to learn about and investigate any of the Travel Services made available through the Services (for example, when you choose to read about a certain Travel Service or look at specific materials available through the Services about a certain Travel Service (i.e. images, video, audio);

- 3.3. if and when you choose to like and/or share a certain Travel Service or other aspect or feature of the Services;
- 3.4. in the event you enter into any transaction through the Services (for example, in connection with Using any Travel Service), (i) Personal Information about yourself or someone on whose behalf you are authorized act (including other travelers in the event you make any arrangements for a Travel Service for multiple individuals) as required or requested by Suppliers and other third parties involved with making these arrangements, and (ii) transaction information such as, but not necessarily limited to, billing address, fulfillment instructions (if any), and credit card or payment card information (such information may in part or in whole constitute Personal Information); provided, however, that Six will not actually collect or retain any credit card or payment card information that would require the Services to be PCI-compliant; that information will instead be retained by the third-party payment provider that Six partners with for these purposes.
- 3.5. records and copies of your correspondence (including email addresses), if you contact us;
- 3.6. your responses to surveys that we might ask you to complete for research purposes;
- 3.7. any information you submit to be published or displayed (hereinafter, "**posted**") on any public areas of any of the Services that we maintain;
- 3.8. any information you send to any third parties, including but not necessarily limited to Suppliers, through the Services, whether about yourself or others (for example, other individuals using a Travel Service with you);
- 3.9. information about the computer you use to access the Services, any related equipment and your internet connection, including your IP address, operating system, and browser type;
- 3.10. information about how you Use the Services or any feature of the Services, which may include Site, Application or Webview traffic data, location data, logs, and other communication data and the resources that you access and Use on or through the Services;
- 3.11. information about how you Use any Travel Service;
- 3.12. if you register or login to the Services through a Social Networking Service, information (possibly including Personal Information) provided by that Social Networking Service that you allow us to access (for more information, see <https://www.facebook.com/about/privacy>; <https://www.linkedin.com/legal/privacy-policy>; and/or <https://www.google.com/policies/privacy/>; and
- 3.13. information about your online activities over time and across third-party websites or other online services as discussed in greater detail in Section 5 below.

You acknowledge and agree that in the event that on or through any of the Services or using any other method you provide us or any third parties (including any Suppliers) with any Personal Information or other potentially sensitive information about any individual or legal entity other than yourself, you are hereby representing to us that you have full legal authorized by or on behalf of that individual or legal entity to share such Personal Information and/or such other information.

4. HOW WE COLLECT INFORMATION ABOUT YOU.

We collect information about you:

- 4.1. directly from you when you provide it to us including, but not limited to, when you create an Account, Use any of the Services, Use any Travel Service, sign up for any online publication we may publish, complete a transaction, run search queries on or through any of the Services, correspond with Six, or respond to one of our surveys or other inquiries;
- 4.2. automatically as you Use and navigate through any of the Services;
- 4.3. automatically when you use the Payment Processor to complete any payment transaction on or through the Services. Please note that this Privacy Policy does not apply to any Personal Information or other information that you provide to an online payment service such as the Payment Processor except to the extent that information is transferred to any of the Services;
- 4.4. through the use of automatic data collection technologies, such as browser cookies; and/or
- 4.5. from third parties, for example, our business partners; and/or,
- 4.6. directly from you if and when you upload any documents or other materials to any of the Services.

5. INFORMATION WE COLLECT THROUGH AUTOMATIC DATA COLLECTION TECHNOLOGIES; DO NOT TRACK SIGNALS.

- 5.1. As stated above, we may use automatic data collection technologies to collect certain information including, but not necessarily limited to, information about or in connection with you, your activities on the Services or otherwise, the computer you Use to access the Services, your browser and your internet connection.
- 5.2. The technologies we may use for this automatic data collection include but are not necessarily limited to the following:

5.2.1. **Cookies and Pixel Tags.** Cookies are small data files containing a string of characters, such as an anonymous unique browser identifier. Cookies are stored on your computer or other device and act as unique tags that identify your device or browser. Our servers may send your device a cookie when you visit the Services, and our vendors, partners and service providers may do likewise on the Services, on their websites, and elsewhere. A pixel tag (also commonly known as a web beacon or clear GIF) is an invisible 1 x 1 pixel that is placed on certain web pages. When you access web pages on which a pixel tag is deployed, the pixel tag may generate a generic notice of the visit and permit Six, our vendors, partners and service providers to set or read cookies. Pixel tags are used in combination with cookies to anonymously track the activity on a website by a particular browser on a particular device. If you disable cookies, pixel tags simply detect an anonymous website visit. Six, alone or with our vendors, partners and service providers, may use cookies to, among other things, “remember” you (e.g., when you visit the Services or the websites of our vendors, partners and service providers), track trends, and collect information about how you use our vendors,

partners and service providers websites or interact with advertising. We use cookies to provide relevant content to you and replace non-relevant ads with ads that better match your interests.

5.2.2. **Google Analytics.** Google Analytics collects information such as how often you and other Users access the Services, what pages they visit when they do so, and what other websites they visited prior to using the Services. We use the information we get from Google Analytics only to improve the Services. Google Analytics collects only the IP address assigned to you on the date you visit the Services, rather than your name or other identifying information. Although Google Analytics plants a permanent cookie on your web browser to identify you as a unique user the next time you visit the Services, the cookie cannot be used by anyone but Google. Google's ability to use and share information collected by Google Analytics about your visits to the Services is restricted by the Google Analytics Terms of Use (<http://www.google.com/analytics/tos.html>) and the Google Privacy Policy (<http://www.google.com/privacypolicy.html>). You can prevent Google Analytics from recognizing you on return visits to the Services by disabling cookies on your browser.

5.3. The information we collect automatically may include Personal Information. In addition, we may maintain or associate such automatically collected information with Personal Information we collect in other ways or receive from third parties. These activities help us to improve the Services and to deliver a better and more personalized service, including but not limited to enabling us to: estimate our audience size and usage patterns; store information about your preferences, which allows us to customize the Services according to your individual interests and needs; speed up your searches; and, recognize you when you return to the Services. **Please note that if you refuse to accept the cookies on or through the Services by selecting the applicable settings on your browser, you may not be able to log on to the Services and the Services may not function as intended for you.**

5.4. **In addition, please note that the Services will not respond or operate differently in any way in response to any Do-Not-Track signals it receives from your web browser. If that is not acceptable to you, please immediately terminate your Account and discontinue any further Use of the Services and the Travel Services.**

6. THIRD-PARTY USE OF COOKIES AND OTHER TRACKING TECHNOLOGIES.

Some content or applications on the Services are served by third-parties, including content providers, and application providers. These third parties may use cookies alone or possibly in conjunction with other tracking technologies to collect information about you when you Use the Services. The information these third parties collect may be associated with your Personal Information or they may collect information, including Personal Information, about your online activities over time and across different websites and other online services. They may use this information to provide you with interest-based (behavioral) advertising or other targeted content.

We do not control these third parties' tracking technologies or how they may be used. If you have any questions about an advertisement or other targeted content, you should contact the responsible provider directly. For information about how you can opt out of receiving these kinds of targeted advertising.

7. HOW WE USE YOUR INFORMATION.

We use information that we collect about you or that you provide to us, including any Personal Information:

- 7.1. to present the Services and their contents to you;
- 7.2. to provide you with information, products, or services that you request from us or that we provide or make available to you, including but not necessarily limited to Travel Services;
- 7.3. to enable you to Use the Services in order to book, pay for and take other actions in connection with those Travel Services you are interested in (and this occurs in conjunction with the information you provide to our Payment Processor through your Use of the Services for this purpose), including sharing certain of your information (potentially including Personal Information) as required with Suppliers and other third-party partners and vendors specifically for this purpose;
- 7.4. to provide to Suppliers or other third parties that may offer and/or provide you with any Travel Service or that we use to help arrange your Use of any Travel Service, and who receive information concerning you (including Personal Information when and as required) specifically for that purpose;
- 7.5. to provide you with confirmations, notifications and updates about the Travel Services you are Using;
- 7.6. to respond to your questions and comments;
- 7.7. to measure interest in and improve the Services and the Travel Services that are offered through them;
- 7.8. to customize your experience with the Services;
- 7.9. to reward you as part of any reward and recognition program that Six may offer or participate in that you choose to join;
- 7.10. to solicit information from you, including through surveys;
- 7.11. to provide you with notices about your Account, including any expiration, suspension, termination and renewal notices;
- 7.12. to resolve disputes, collect fees, troubleshoot problems and/or carry out our obligations and enforce our rights arising from the Terms or any other agreements entered into between you and us, including for billing and collection;
- 7.13. to notify you about changes to the Services, any Travel Services or any other products or services we may offer, provide or make available through the Services;
- 7.14. to allow you to participate in any interactive features of the Services;

- 7.15. to provide to our third-party vendors who assist us with operating, maintaining, and improving the Services by providing us with services, such as email delivery, operation of discussion forums, other information technology services, payment processing services and other services, and who receive your data for the limited purposes of providing us with such services;
- 7.16. to promote on through the Services or to contact you about any other special offers, services and products offered by SIX that we believe may be of interest to you; and, to promote on or through the Services, or to contact you about, any Travel Services or any other third-party special offers, services and products that we believe may be of interest to you;
- 7.17. to enable us to display advertisements that are targeted at you and that are displayed on third-party websites and through other online channels about the Services, any Travel Services or any other products or services Six may directly offer, directly provide or otherwise make available to you in any other way we may describe when you provide the information; and/or
- 7.18. to fulfill any other purpose for which you provide it; and
- 7.19. for any other purpose with your consent.

8. DISCLOSURE OF YOUR INFORMATION.

- 8.1. We may disclose aggregated, anonymized information about our Users and their activities in connection with the Services, any of its features or any Travel Services without restriction provided such information does not disclose the identify any specific User or identify any specific User as the source of any such information.
- 8.2. We may disclose Personal Information that we collect or you provide as described in this Privacy Policy:
 - 8.2.1.to our subsidiaries and affiliates;
 - 8.2.2. to Suppliers and other third parties as necessary in connection with your Use or proposed Use of any Travel Services such Suppliers may offer and/or provide and such other third parties may assist in arranging. By making Using any of the Services to book, reserve, pay for or take any similar action in connection with a Travel Service, you are authorizing us to disclose to the applicable Supplier(s) and other third parties such information as is required to complete these activities so as to enable the successful delivery of the applicable Travel Services. PLEASE NOTE THAT THE SUPPLIERS AND THE THIRD PARTIES REFERRED TO IN THIS SECTION 8.2.2 ARE NOT CONTROLLED BY SIX AND PERSONAL INFORMATION DISCLOSED TO THEM IS SUBJECT TO THE APPLICABLE SUPPLIER'S/OTHER THIRD PARTY'S PRIVACY POLICY AND SECURITY PRACTICES. THEREFORE, WE ENCOURAGE YOU TO REVIEW THE PRIVACY POLICIES OF ANY SUPPLIER WHOSE TRAVEL SERVICES YOU OBTAIN THROUGH THIS SITE;
 - 8.2.3.to contractors, service providers, and other third parties we use to support the Services and our business and that are bound by contractual obligations to keep Personal Information confidential and use it only for the purposes for which we disclose it to them;

- 8.2.4. business partners with whom we may jointly offer products or services, or whose products or services may be offered on or through the Services. You can tell when such a third party is involved in a product or service you have requested because their name will appear, either alone or with ours. If the event you choose to Use any of these jointly offered products and services, Six may share information about you, including your Personal Information, with those business partners. Please note that we do not control the privacy practices of these third-party business partners;
- 8.2.5. to a buyer or other successor in the event of a merger, divestiture, restructuring, reorganization, dissolution, or other sale or transfer of some or all of Six's assets, whether as a going concern or as part of bankruptcy, liquidation, or similar proceeding, in which Personal Information held by Six about the Services' Users is among the assets transferred;
- 8.2.6. to fulfill the purpose for which you provide it. For example, if you give us an email address to use an "email a friend" feature of the Services, we will transmit the contents of that email and your email address to the recipients;
- 8.2.7. for any other purpose disclosed by us when you provide the information; and/or
- 8.2.8. otherwise with your consent.

8.3. We may also disclose your Personal Information:

- 8.3.1. to comply with any court order, law, or legal process, including to respond to any government or regulatory request;
- 8.3.2. to enforce or apply the Terms, this Privacy Policy, or to carry out our obligations and enforce our rights arising from any other agreements entered into between you and us, including any obligations and rights related to billing and collection; and/or
- 8.3.3. if we believe disclosure is necessary or appropriate to protect the rights, property, or safety of Six, our Users or others. This may include exchanging information with other companies and organizations for the purposes of fraud protection and credit risk reduction.

9. CHOICES ABOUT HOW WE USE AND DISCLOSE YOUR INFORMATION.

We strive to provide you with choices regarding the Personal Information you provide to us. We have created mechanisms to provide you with the following control over your information:

- 9.1. **Tracking Technologies and Advertising.** You can set your browser to refuse all or some cookies, or to alert you when cookies are being sent. If you disable or refuse cookies, please note that some parts of the Services may then be inaccessible or not function properly. Furthermore, if you choose to disable or refuse cookies in your web browser, other websites you visit may be inaccessible or not function properly.
- 9.2. **Promotional Offers from Six or from Third Parties.** If you do not wish to have your contact information used by Six or by any of our third party partners to promote any Travel Services or any other products or services we offer, you can opt out by sending us an email stating your request to hello@six.travel or, if and when you receive a promotional email from us or any third

party, you may select the 'unsubscribe' link in that promotional email or instead send us or that third party a return email asking to be omitted from future promotional email distributions. Please note that this opt-out right does not apply to information provided to or by Six in connection with any Travel Service or other product or service offered by us that you are Using or have previously Used, any transaction you have entered into or have attempted to enter into through the Services, any payments you have made or have attempted to make through or otherwise related to the Services or any Travel Service, any technical or customer care in connection with the Services or any Travel Service you have Used or attempted to Use, or any communications about these Terms or any other agreement that both you and Six are party to.

9.3. PROMOTION OFFERS FROM THIRD PARTIES.

Also, as stated above, please note that we do not control third parties' collection or use of your information to serve interest-based advertising. However, those third parties may provide you with ways to choose not to have your information collected or used in this way. You can opt out of receiving targeted ads from members of the Network Advertising Initiative ("**NAI**") on the NAI's website.

10. ACCESSING AND CORRECTING YOUR INFORMATION.

10.1. You can review the Personal Information we have linked with your Account by logging into any of the Services and visiting your Account profile.

10.2. If you have reason to believe that any of such Personal Information (as shown in your Account profile) is inaccurate, erroneous, or incomplete, you will have the ability to correct that Personal Information by visiting your Account profile through any of the Services and making such changes directly. If for any reason, you are unable to do this, you can inform us of desired changes by emailing us at care@six.travel with a description of what Personal Information is inaccurate, erroneous, incomplete and/or out-of-date and how it should be corrected.

10.3. While you can request that certain of your Personal Information be deleted, you acknowledge that, in various instances, this may not be possible without also deleting your Account altogether. Furthermore, Six may, in its sole discretion, choose to not accommodate a request to change or delete any or all of your Personal Information if we believe the change or deletion could be considered a violation of any applicable law, statute, regulation, ordinance, judgment, decision or other legal requirement, or cause your Personal Information to be incorrect or erroneous or to include or increase any material omission.

10.4. You have the right at any time to terminate your Six Account; provided, however, that this will not affect any outstanding obligations you have at that time. If you select that option, you will be sent an email confirming the deletion of your Account. If you confirm the deletion of your Account, then all your User-related information (including your Personal Information) shall be deleted from Six's systems subject to terms of [Section 14](#) ("Retention of Your Personal Information") below.

11. ADDITIONAL TERMS FOR INFLUENCERS.

11.1. In order to simplify our registration and login process, if you are party to a Six Travel Influencer Agreement (an "**Influencer**") or Hotel Partner Agreement (a "**Hotel**"), we may require you to login and link your Account with the Instagram social networking service (an "**Instagram**")

Login”). When enabled, the Instagram Login will authenticate your identity, will allow you to log into the Services using a single Instagram Login button, and will share certain Personal Information with Six Travel that you hereby or elsewhere authorize us to collect.

11.2. If you register or login to the Services through the Instagram Login , we will need and thus request your permission to access your data on and through the Instagram Login to create an Account for you or to update that Account. In addition, we may use this data for certain other purposes, including:

11.2.1. **Populating Account and Profile Fields:** when you are connected via the Instagram Login, we may pre-populate and update your Account with data from the Instagram Login; and

11.2.2. **Aggregate Reporting:** when you are connected via the Instagram Login, we may use data made available through the Instagram Login that you authorize us to access to learn more about the demographic information of Users and Influencers like yourself.

11.3. You may disassociate yourself from the Instagram Login at any time by visiting the Account section of your profile on the Services.

11.4. No information about you collected on or through the Services will be shared with Instagram without your authorization. This means, for example, that nothing will be posted to or through Instagram unless you give us specific permission to do so, and your Instagram contacts will not be contacted at any time. The Services will not store or utilize the names of your Instagram contacts even if they are provided to the Services by Instagram or through the Instagram Login.

11.5. Instagram may vary the level of control over the extent to which content or information you may submit to the Services is also made public and shared on Instagram. When you use the Instagram Login to log into the Services:

11.5.1. you share your information with it and its privacy policy applies to Instagram's collection, use, and disclosure of such information;

11.5.2. Instagram may be able to collect information about you, including your activity on or through the Services and in connection with the Travel Services, and it may notify your connections on Instagram about your Use of the Services and the Travel Services; and

11.5.3. Instagram may also employ unique identifiers that allow your activity to be monitored across multiple websites for purposes of delivering targeted advertising to you.

11.6. Please note that the privacy policies and terms of use of Instagram may be different from those of the Services. Please read them and also familiarize yourself with the privacy controls and account settings on Instagram for information on how to customize your privacy settings with respect to content or information submitted to the Services.

12. YOUR CALIFORNIA PRIVACY RIGHTS.

California Civil Code Section § 1798.83 permits users of the Services that are California residents to request certain information regarding our disclosure of Personal Information to third parties for their direct marketing purposes. To make such a request, please send an email to hello@six.travel.

13. DATA SECURITY.

We have implemented a variety of industry-standard measures designed to secure your Personal Information from accidental loss and from unauthorized access, use, alteration, and disclosure. Among other measures, Six uses industry-standard data protection technologies, including Secure Sockets Layer (SSL) transmission, password-protected database storage, and secured servers. All Personal Information and any other information related to payment transactions will be protected by industry-standard encryption and data protection measures at all times; provided, however, that any Payment Method information you provide to the Payment Processor that would require the Services to be PCI-compliant will not be stored on Six's computer systems.

The safety and security of your information also depends on you. Where we have given you (or where you have chosen) a password for access to certain parts of the Services, you are responsible for keeping this password confidential. We ask you not to share your password with anyone. We urge you to be careful about giving out information in public areas of the Services. The information you share in such public areas may be viewed by any User of the Services.

Unfortunately, the transmission of information via the Internet is not completely secure. Although we do our best to protect your Personal Information, we cannot guarantee the security of your Personal Information transmitted to the Services. Any transmission of Personal Information is at your own risk. We are not responsible for circumvention of any privacy settings or security measures contained on the Services.

14. RETENTION OF PERSONAL INFORMATION.

Certain of your Personal Information required for your Account (including but not necessarily limited to information such as your name, date of birth, email address, login credentials and passwords for the Services) shall be retained until you or Six chooses to delete your Account on the Services. Furthermore, Six reserves the right to retain certain Personal Information indefinitely in connection with Six's books and records, such as a customer list or a record of transactions conducted through the Services. Other than the Personal Information described in the preceding sentences, all your Personal Information shall be automatically deleted from the Services within no later than thirty (30) days of the expiration or termination of your Account unless (i) Six is required to do otherwise by any applicable law, statute, regulation, ordinance, judgment, decision or other legal requirement, or (ii) Six has reason to believe retaining some or all of such Personal Information is necessary or appropriate to protect the rights, property, or safety of Six, other Users, or others, including but not limited for the purposes of fraud protection and credit risk reduction. In addition, certain of your payment-related Personal Information will not be deleted in the event that you have selected or are otherwise obligated to make any recurring payments through the Services.

15. CHANGES TO OUR PRIVACY POLICY.
